Avalon Outreach Program

Avalon provides one-on-one psychosocial rehabilitation support to adults with a mental illness who live independently in the City of Moreland. The program aims to encourage participants to live as independently as possible within the community. Areas of support include: budgeting, health referral & advocacy, transport training and linking into services such as neighbourhood houses and employment agencies.

To be eligible for this program, individuals must:

- Have a diagnosed mental illness
- Live in the City of Moreland and be aged between 18 and 65 years of age
- Have the ongoing support of a clinical health professional
- Be willing to participate in the program

Linx Outreach Program

The Linx Outreach Program provides assertive outreach to individuals experiencing mental health issues, who live in Supported Residential Services (SRS) and rooming/boarded houses in the City of Moreland. The program provides both individual one-on-one support, as well as facilitating group programs for clients.

The Linx Outreach Program works with individuals who often have complex needs and may be difficult to engage. The program aims to support clients to engage with the community, and to enhance their mental, physical and social well being.

To be eligible for the program, individuals must:

- Be living within a SRS or rooming/boarded house in the City of Moreland
- Be aged between 18 - 65 years of age
- Have diagnosed mental illness
- Have the ongoing support of clinical health professional
