



Dental Services

Emergency

Emergency dental treatment is available at the Brunswick clinic for all current pension card and HCC holders.

When clients contact the Brunswick site today on (03) 9387 6711 the dental condition will be assessed within 24 hours and treatment arranged if required. The cost of treatment varies according to your circumstances but is usually \$23.00 per visit.

Staff will ask the client four or five questions to quickly work out what the dental condition is. This information will be used to assess the treatment needs and arrange an appropriate appointment if required.

Please note that at times there is a high demand for emergency services and patients may be triaged to the RDHM.

General dental services

General adult dental services are provided.

For clients who wish to have convention dental treatment they will need to present with a current HCC or Pension card to the Brunswick site in person to place their name on the waiting list.

Waiting lists will vary depending on the client's age and dental requirements.

Who can use the service?

If you are over 18 years of age and hold a current

health care or pensioner concession card you are eligible to go on a waiting list for general dental care.

Non card holders will need to access the private sector.

What type of care is provided for adults?

- Dental check-ups and advice
- Dental sealants to prevent decay
- Teeth cleaning
- Fillings
- Extractions
- Denture services

How much does it cost?

- The treatment fee is \$23 per visit, up to a maximum of \$92 per course of care.
- Acrylic dentures will generally cost no more than \$115.

Children

The Early Childhood Oral Health Program for children aged 0-6 years as well as primary school children grade prep to grade 6. This will focus on prevention of oral disease and provides dental treatment at community dental clinics.

If clients are interested in accessing general dental treatment for their child please advise the parent's carers to contact the Brunswick site.

Type of care provided

All general dental treatment is provided including:

- Dental check-ups and advice
- Dental sealants to prevent decay
- Teeth cleaning
- Fillings

How much does it cost?

- The service is free for your child if you hold a current health care or pensioner card.
- Non-concession cardholders pay a fee of \$28 per child per course of care, which includes a dental examination and all general treatment.

Teens

Brunswick provides a range of dental care services for children and adolescents. No waiting period is required.

Type of care provided

All general dental treatment is provided including:

- Dental check-ups and advice
- Dental sealants to prevent decay
- Teeth cleaning
- Fillings

How much does it cost?

The service is free for your child if you hold a current health care or pensioner card. Non card holders will need the access the private sector.
